



The Sacrament of Baptism

The following guidelines apply for children who are enrolled in All Saints Family Faith Formation and/or All Saints Catholic School that are in preparation to receive the Holy Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist, and are between the ages of 6 -13.

TRANSFER STUDENTS WHO NEED SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

Unbaptized transfer students from other Catholic Schools or other Children's Faith Formation Programs must present documentation of at least one year of Faith Formation before enrolling in Baptism Classes. Two Baptism Preparation Classes will be offered for children and their parents on

Thursday, September 21st and Thursday, September 28th at 7:00 p.m.

After completing **BOTH** classes, the children may receive the Sacrament of Baptism in October, preferably in a group setting.

FIRST YEAR STUDENTS WHO NEED SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

Unbaptized students who complete one year of Faith Formation at All Saints Catholic School or one year of Family Faith Formation on Sundays will enroll in two Baptism Preparation Classes, accompanied by their parents. These classes will be offered for children and their parents on

Thursday, April 19th and 26th at 7:00 p.m. in English.

Friday, April 20th and 27th in Spanish.

After completing **BOTH** classes, the children may receive the Sacrament of Baptism in May, preferably in a group setting.
